Plan

- Holding off on Feline URD Panel for now since abx restarted 3 days ago and due to cost of testing.
- Will start NeoPolyDex to see if this helps reduce conjunctival swelling and if entropion improves. If no improvement w/in 3 days (or if worsening) o to call. Warned of problems using steroid if FHV present.
- Rx: NeoPolyDex Suspension - 1 drop OU BID x 5-7 days; then SID x 3-5 days
- Put in online Rx for VetriLysine Treats (VFC)

Plan

- Will start trial w/TAO and monitor response. Avoiding use of steroid in case of FHV. Disc'd possibility of FHV. Foster to call if no improvement after 3-5 days of eye meds.
- Rx: NeoPolyBac - apply OU TID x 7-10 days
